Deone Guidelines

Due to our proximity to Concord Municipal Airport (CON), any drone/UAS operations require approval from the FAA through LAANC (Low Altitude Authorization and Notification Capability), which is a feature in all modern UAS Flight Software.

# Who is allowed to operate a drone at the Barn at Bull Meadow?

Only pre-approved vendors who are Part 107 Certified <u>and</u> have provided a C.O.I. (Certificate of Insurance) to the day-of coordinator may operate a UAS on the property. Due to the risk to other guests and property, no guests may operate a drone anywhere on the property.

# What if I'm staying low?

The approval through LAANC is required regardless of the altitude of the Drone/UAS. Standard LAANC approval for our location is under 400' AGL. Any altitudes higher than that will require additional approval from the FAA.

# Where can I fly my drone?

Drone operations are to be confined to the parking lot, ceremony site, front and sides of the Barn, and the back patio. Drones are not permitted inside or above the Barn or under the tent. Additionally, to be respectful to our neighbors (and one of the owners who lives on site), please maintain line-ofsight operation to ensure you don't overfly any homes or buildings.
